Winter 2020 Federal Report Prince Edward Island





PEI FEDERAL HIGHLIGHTS



Introduction

MQO Research spoke with 400 residents of Prince Edward Island to gauge the political temperature in the province for the Winter edition of our quarterly political poll: Atlantic Matters.

Federal Politics

According to the latest polling numbers, support for the Conservatives increased on Prince Edward Island this quarter pushing them into a statistical tie with the Liberals. Among decided and leaning voters:

- o Conservative support increased 7 percentage points to 41%.
- Support for the Liberal Party held relatively steady at 38% in March.
- Support for the Green Party dropped 10 percentage points to 11%.
- o NDP support increased 5 percentage points to 9%.

The Atlantic Matters poll was conducted by telephone from March 3^{rd} to March 10^{th} , 2020 and included 400 randomly selected eligible voters from across the province. The margin of error for the total sample is \pm 4.9 percentage points 19 times out of 20.










FEDERAL POLITICS – PEI TREND
